### DIRECTIONS:

Via Deception Pass Bridge: From I-5, take exit 230 to Anacortes/Whidbey Island and follow Highway 20 and signs to Oak Harbor. Continue through Oak Harbor toward Coupeville approximately 6 miles.

At Hastie Lake Road – TURN RIGHT

At West Beach Road – TURN LEFT

At Van Dam Road – TURN LEFT – Follow to the end. North entrance to the site is directly across from the stop sign. Enter into the field and proceed to the top of the hill, through the gate, through the woods into the campground.

Via Ferry: Take the Mukilteo-Clinton Ferry

Follow Highway 525 North to Coupeville. Continue through Coupeville on Highway 20 (for approximately 4 miles beyond the overpass in Coupeville).

At Zylstra Road – TURN LEFT

Wind up the hill past Arnold Road.

Site will be on your right.

Enter site at North Gate, directly across from Van Dam Road. Enter field and proceed to the top of the hill, through the gate, through the wood into the campground.

**RELEASE:** I understand that this is a high-risk sport and I am participating at my own risk. I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless the organizer, organizing committee, judges and officials, volunteers, the Whidbey Island Horse Trials Foundation, its officers, and the property owner from all liability for negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses which I will compete at this event.

**Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification. This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this competition to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, lessee, owner, agent, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm")

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Whidbey Island Horse Trials Foundation, its Organizers and Volunteers, and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Whidbey Island Horse Trials Foundation or the Competition Organizers.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Whidbey Island Horse Trials Foundation or the Competition Organizers.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Whidbey Island Horse Trials Foundation and the Competition Organizers and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I understand that it is my responsibility to wear appropriate protective equipment.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this completion.
